2019 Annual Giving Campaign

Our focus for this years campaign is transportation. The Club is in need of a new van. We transport an average of 80 riders each day from school and then home at the end of club programs. During the summer kids are picked up at home and dropped off. EYC transportation travels over 58 miles each day including Bear River, Hilliard, Yellow Creek Estates, Grass Valley, and many more.



Our current EYC transportation fleet consists of 2 fifteen passenger vans (2015), 1 fifteen passenger van (2001), and 1 seven passenger mini-van (2013). The 2001 van is currently experiencing major mechanical problems and is no longer safe to transport youth. Our fleet is not meeting the transportation needs of our program. Weather, distance, and darkness makes it unsafe for most youth members to walk home. Unfortunately, many parents are working and unable to provide transportation for their youth to Evanston Youth Club programs.
